## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Defining the Word "Teacher" under Teachers' Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, amended. Chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 227-A and to read as follows:

'Sec. 227-A. Definition of teacher. The word "teacher" as used in sections 219 to 227, inclusive, shall have the following meaning: any teacher, principal, supervisor, school nurse, school secretary, or superintendent employed in any day school in the state.'
