AN ACT Relative to **Hunting Foxes with Hounds in the County of Franklin.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 72, amended. Section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be designated (1) and to read as follows:

‘(1) **Provided, further, it shall be lawful for any person to hunt foxes with hounds in the county of Franklin from October 1st to October 15th, both days inclusive, and from February 16th to March 31st, both days inclusive; but provided, further, it shall be unlawful to dig out or molest fox dens during said extended open season in said Franklin county.**’
