AN ACT Relating to the Definition of "Teachers" in Re the Teachers' Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 228, sub-§ (1), amended. Subsection (1) of section 228 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'(1) "Teacher" shall mean any teacher, principal, supervisor, school nurse, school secretary, **janitor, school-bus operator**, or superintendent employed in any **public** day school within the state; also a teacher or principal of a normal school, the commissioner of education or his assistants, and teachers who teach in any school which is supported at least 3/5 by state or town appropriations.'
