STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Central Aroostook Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Extension of the charter of the Central Aroostook Railway Company. The rights, powers, privileges and franchises of the Central Aroostook Railway Company, as heretofore granted by the legislature, are hereby continued in force and extended for 2 years from the time this act goes into effect, and all the rights, powers, privileges and franchises which were granted or have been acquired by virtue of previous acts, may, and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as provided in chapter 41 of the private and special laws of 1913, and chapter 11 of the private and special laws of 1937 except as hereinafter provided.
- Sec. 2. How the act shall be construed. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal, or shall be construed as repealing, the whole or any part of any existing statute, and all rights and duties herein mentioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance with all the applicable provisions of chapter 62 of the revised statutes of 1930, and all acts amendatory thereof or additional thereto.
