STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Forbidding the Planting of Chippewa Potatoes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Planting of "Chippewa" potatoes, forbidden. It is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor for any person, firm or corporation to plant in the state any "Chippewa" potatoes.
