STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Open Season on Foxes in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 72, amended. The 8th paragraph of subsection (a) of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The open season on all other fur-bearing animals, including raccoons, shall be from October 16th to February 15th (bobcats, loupcervier, Canada lynx are not fur-bearing within the meaning of this section); except that in York county the open season on foxes shall be from October 1st to the last day of February, inclusive.'
