STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Farm Tractors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 50, amended. Section 50 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto, after the 3rd paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

'No registration or license shall be required to permit the use of a tractor on any way leading to and from the premises when the tractor is to be used for agricultural purposes.'
