#### RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land to Enos Drumm, of Thomaston, Connecticut.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Enos Drumm of Thomaston, Connecticut, whatever interest the state may have in lot 128 in I range I, NBKP (Rockwood) containing I acre more or less and having an assessed valuation of \$300, for the sum of \$128.81.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

The check for \$128.81 is in the hands of the state treasurer which compensates the state for the taxes due on the land.
