## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Recorder of the Houlton Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1911, c. 154, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 44 of the private and special laws of 1915, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Compensation of judge and recorder; condition precedent to payment. The judge of said court shall receive as compensation a salary of \$1,200 a year; and the recorder shall receive a salary of five hundred dollars \$1,000 a year to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook. A condition precedent to the payment of said salaries as aforesaid shall be the rendering by said judge and recorder of a correct statement, to the county commissioners of said county of Aroostook, and the payment over by said judge and recorder to the county treasurer, of all fees both civil and criminal, collected by said court for the preceding quarter or fractional part thereof.'
