#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Recorder of the Bath Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1941, c. 32, amended. That part designated 'Sec. 2' of chapter 32 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Qualifications of judge and recorder; salary. Said judge and recorder shall be members of the bar of Sagadahoc county, and shall reside during their continuance in office in said county. The judge of said court shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$1,650 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. Said recorder shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$600 \$1,000 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. Both salaries shall be in full for all fees and emoluments of their respective offices.'
- Sec. 2. Duration of act. This act shall remain in force for a period of 2 years only.
