RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Aroostook County to Joseph David of Edmunston, N. B.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Joseph David, of Edmunston, N. B. whatever interest the state has in land in Township 17, Range 4, W. E. L. S., for the sum of \$53.80.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land was formerly assessed to Maurice Bernier and was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1941 for 1939 taxes and in 1942 for 1940 taxes. Mr. David, who was a former owner, is desirous of obtaining this land by paying the taxes in arrears. The taxes in arrears with interest and cost to 1942, inclusive, amounts to \$53.80. A certified check for this amount is in the hands of the treasurer of state.
