STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Beaver.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38, § 72, sub-§ (a), amended. The last paragraph of subsection (a) of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘The open season on all other fur-bearing animals, including raccoons, shall be from October 16th to February 15th (bobcats, loupcevrier, Canada lynx, **and beaver** are not fur-bearing within the meaning of this section).

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 38, § 72, sub-§ (e), repealed. Subsection (e) of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed.
