STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting Bear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 38, § 72, sub-§ (c), amended. Subsection (c) of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- '(c) It shall be lawful to trap bear at any time, anywhere, in the state, and it shall be lawful to hunt bear at any time, anywhere in the state except on Sundays and in the night-time.'
