**RESOLVE, Relating to the Rules and Regulations on the Fishing for
White Perch in Three-Mile Pond, in the County of Kennebec.**

Taking of white perch in Three-Mile pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized to issue a rule and regulation permitting the taking of white perch in Three-Mile pond in the towns of China, Vassalboro, and Windsor, in the county of Kennebec, from the time the ice is out to September 30th.
