STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Matron of the Kennebec County Jail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 94, § 31, amended. Section 31 of chapter 94 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Provided, however, that the county commissioners in Kennebec county may employ a matron for the jail and pay her a salary not to exceed \$1,000 per year.'
