STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of Clerks in the Office of Register of Probate of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$800, and such additional sum not exceeding \$300, when necessary, subject to the approval of the county commissioners; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$500 \$1,000; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$200.'
