STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Wine in the Manufacturing of Patented Medicines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 300, § 7-A, amended. Section 7-A of chapter 300 of the public laws of 1933, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 232 of the public laws of 1937, and as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the 1st paragraph thereof the following:

'Provided, however, that manufacturers of patented medicines who use wines in their medicines may purchase such wine from within or without the state, and that the same may be transported to such manufacturers, and that they may sell such patented medicines, and that no state tax shall be levied on such wine.'
