AN ACT Permitting Non-resident Citizens to Transport Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 66, amended. Section 66 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘; provided, however, that any resident of this state who maintains another habitation without the state may transport a deer legally killed within this state by him to his other habitation.’
