STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Creating the Lily Bay Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 90, amended. Section 90 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended, by adding thereto, after that part of said section which describes Katahdin Wild Life Sanctuary, the following:

'Lily Bay: Beginning at a red post set on the shores of Moosehead Lake about 7/8 of a mile south of Stevens Point, which Stevens Point is at the entrance of Spencer Bay; thence following the shore of Moosehead Lake westerly and southerly to the mouth of Plant brook; thence following the course of this brook about 3/4 of a mile to a red post; thence northwesterly in a straight line to the point of beginning.'
