STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of Various Officers of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 41, amended. That part of section 41 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, which relates to Waldo county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, fourteen hundred dollars \$1,600,'

Sec. 2. R. S, c. 125, § 42, amended. That part of section 42 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, which relates to Waldo county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, fifteen hundred dollars \$1,800,'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 124, § 44, amended. That part of section 44 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, which relates to Waldo county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, one thousand dollars \$1,300,'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Waldo county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, fifteen hundred sixty dollars \$1,872; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$780; for clerks in the office of the clerk of courts, \$200 \$1,040.'

Sec. 5. Limitation. The provisions of this act shall remain in effect for a period of 2 years only.

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
