STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Board of Trustees of the Jointly Contributory Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 227-K, and sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 227-K of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, as enacted by chapter 328 of the public laws of 1941, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- '(1) The general administration and responsibility for the proper operation of the retirement system and for making effective the provisions of this act are hereby vested in a board of 3 trustees. The board shall consist of the state controller, ex officio, and 2 trustees who shall be appointed by the governor, subject to the approval of the council, for terms of 4 years; provided, however, that of the first 2 appointed trustees one shall be appointed for a term of 2 years. If a vacancy occurs in the office of a trustee, the vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as the office was previously filled The board shall consist of the chairman of the state personnel board, the state treasurer, and the state controller, ex officio; their terms of office as such board members to run concurrently with their terms in said state positions.'
