STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hours of Labor of Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 54, § 22, suspended. The provisions of section 22 of chapter 54 of the revised statutes are hereby suspended for the duration of the present war with Germany, Italy and Japan, and for 6 months thereafter.
