## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend the Act Providing a Pension for Members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Waterville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1941, c. 88, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 88 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:
- '6. Any regular member reaching the age of 65 before the effective date of this act and continuing to serve until the effective date of this amendment shall be entitled to the pension set out in this act upon his honorable discharge as set out in this section provided he has substantially complied with the provisions of section 6.'
