## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Permitting the Extension of the Open Season on Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38, § 61, amended. Section 61 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Provided, however, that whenever in his judgment, the extension of the open season in certain counties will not be detrimental to the conservation of the deer for future hunting purposes, the commissioner, with the approval of the governor and council, may extend the open season in such counties for up to, but not exceeding, 15 days.'

Sec. 2. Duration of act. This act shall remain in force and effect for the duration of the war and 6 months thereafter only.
