RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land to the Great Northern Paper Company.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Great Northern Paper Company, a corporation duly existing under the laws of Maine, and having its place of business at Millinocket, county of Penobscot, state of Maine, whatever interest the state may have in Lot eighty-two (82) in Township 2, Range 3 N. B. K. P. (Soldier-town) county of Somerset. Said lot 82 containing two hundred acres (200) more or less, for the sum of two hundred and ninety-four dollars and eighty-four cents (\$294.84).
