IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing the Amount Paid for Clerk Hire in the Offices of Register of Deeds, Register of Probate and Clerk of Courts in Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Knox county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$10,560; for clerks in the office of register of probate, eight hundred thirty two dollars \$1,560; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$10,560.'
