RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in the Tributaries of Moxie Pond.

Fishing in the tributaries of Moxie pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed and authorized to issue a rule and regulation opening all tributaries of Moxie pond, sometimes called Lake Moxie, situated in Somerset county, to fishing under the general law.
