## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in Office of Clerk of Courts of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$800, and such additional sum not exceeding \$300, when necessary, subject to the approval of the county commissioners; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$500; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, two hundred dollars \$500.'
