## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Granting Increase in Salary for Clerks in the Office of Register of Probate in Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. That part of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes which relates to Androscoggin county, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$2,500; for clerks in the office of register of probate, twelve hundred dollars \$1,500; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$2,000; for clerks in the office of sheriff, \$600.'
