STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Throwing of Bottles, Etc. on the Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, additional. Chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 5-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 5-A. Throwing bottles and cans upon ways, prohibited. It shall be unlawful to throw or deposit on any way, or on land contiguous to any way, any bottles or tin cans except in proper containers for the purpose of leaving them for removal by rubbish collectors. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$10.'
