STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Permitting the State to Render Aid in Organized and Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- **P. L., 1935, c. 1, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 1. State to render aid and relief when municipalities or unorganized territories unable. In any municipality or unorganized territory under the control of the board of emergency municipal finance where it is financially impossible for the community to eare provide for its unemployable direct relief, and work programs, or its contributory share of public assistance programs, the state through the department of health and welfare may render such aid and relief to unemployable persons located in such municipalities or unorganized territory. The inability of municipalities or unorganized territories to provide such necessary aid and relief for their unemployable persons shall be decided by the department commissioner of health and welfare and the state auditor.'
