## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Eating and Lodging Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 187, amended. Section 187 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 187. Department authorized to license; terms and fees. The department is empowered to license eating and lodging places, recreational and overnight camps. Such licenses shall be issued by the department under such terms and conditions as it deems advisable, and fees for licenses not exceeding \$5 may be charged. The fees thus received shall constitute a permanent fund to carry out the provisions of sections 186, 187, and 187-A to 187-D, inclusive, of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933.'
