AN ACT Relating to Parties in Interest in the Trial of Causes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Parties in interest in the trial of causes. At the trial of any civil cause it is competent to show the interest or want of interest of the parties prosecuting or defending said cause, regardless of the fact of whether they are named as parties.
