STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Attached Mortgaged Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 95, § 45, amended. The last paragraph of section 45 of chapter 95 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Such summons shall be made returnable on any day, after to days and within 90 days, of its date to the next regular term of said court to be held after the required service can reasonably be made, and served by copy, attested by the officer making such service, and shall be in order for hearing at the return term. If said mortgage such claimant fails to appear and answer as therein directed, or after hearing, the court may estop him from claiming any interest in such attached or seized goods by virtue of such mortgage, pledge or lien.'
