STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the County Treasurer and Clerk Hire for the County of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 45, amended. The 7th paragraph of section 45 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Kennebec, eighteen hundred dollars \$2,200.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 7th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Kennebec county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$3,000; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$2,100 and said sum shall cover the cost of indexing all documents, papers and records of his office; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$1,500; for clerks in the office of county treasurer, three hundred dollars \$500. The deputy clerk of courts shall receive such additional amount for services as shall be approved by the county commissioners not to exceed \$300 annually.'
