AN ACT Relating to the Choice of Assessors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13 § 86, repealed. Section 86 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and chapter 5 of the revised statutes is amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section 12-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 12-A. Selectmen to act as assessors. If any town does not choose assessors, the selectmen shall be the assessors, and each of them shall be sworn as an assessor.’
