RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Payment of Claims for Damages

Done by Protected Wild Animals.

Appropriation for payment of claims for damages done by protected wild animals. Resolved: That the sum of \$25,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated out of general funds to be used in payment of claims granted by this legislature for damage done to personal property by protected wild animals.
