IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Trial Justices and Judges of Municipal Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 144, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 144 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Every trial justice or judge of a municipal court shall maintain a bank account in the name of the court in which all fines, costs and forfeitures received shall be deposited within 48 hours after their receipt.'
