IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED,
FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Appointment of Heads of All Police Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Heads of police departments to be appointed by the governor. Notwithstanding the provisions of any charters or other provisions of law, all heads of police departments of cities shall be appointed by the governor by and with the advice and consent of the council, for such terms as the respective heads now serve under existing law.
