**AN ACT** Relating to Commitment of Persons of Unsound Mind to the  
State Hospitals for Observation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 414, repealed.** Section 414 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, as amended, is hereby repealed.
