STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reestablish and Continue in Effect the State Highway Planning Survey and Planning Survey Committee, as Created by Chapter 135 of the Resolves of 1937.

Highway planning survey and planning survey committee, reestablished.

Resolved: That chapter 135 of the resolves of 1937 entitled "Resolve Relating to State Planning Survey and Planning Survey Committee," and the powers and duties of the state highway commission and the planning survey committee as constituted in said resolve, be and hereby are reestablished, restored, continued in force and extended for a period of 2 years from the date when this resolve shall become effective or until said committee shall have completed and presented a report of its work to the 92nd legislature or to any special session of the 91st legislature; and be it further

Resolved: That inasmuch as certain members of said committee as constituted at the time of their original appointment, are not now legally qualified to continue in office, and vacancies thereby exist in the personnel of the committee, the governor, the president of the senate and the speaker of the house are hereby each respectively authorized to fill such vacancies by appointment in the same manner as provided in the original resolve.
