# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Malt Beverage Taxes on Government Reservations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1933, c. 268, § 21-A, amended.** Section 21-A of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1933 as enacted by section 2 of chapter 236 of the public laws of 1937, is hereby amended by adding thereto paragraph (c), to read as follows:

'(c) That all taxes, excise and deficiency on malt beverages imposed by the state shall be waived by the commission on malt beverages sold by wholesalers holding licenses from the commission to and on government instrumentalities.'
