AN ACT Relating to Authority of Clerks of Municipal Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authority of clerks of municipal courts. When, by reason of sickness, absence from the county, inability or vacancy in office, no judge or recorder of a municipal court is available to hold a criminal term, the clerk of such court shall continue criminal matters for not exceeding 30 days and may admit to bail respondents.
