RESOLVE, in Favor of Lincoln Academy.

Lincoln academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Lincoln Academy, the sum of \$2000 from July I, 1943 to June 30, 1944, and the sum of \$2000 from July I, 1944 to June 30, 1945, said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said academy. Said amounts are to be taken from the adjustment fund as provided by section 105, paragraph II, of chapter 19 of the revised statutes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This academy serves as a high school for the surrounding territory; it has been long established.
