STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Recorder of the Sanford Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1915, c. 39, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 39 of the private and special laws of 1915, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Salary increased. The recorder of the Sanford municipal court shall receive as compensation, an annual salary of \$800 \$1,200, payable quarterly, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October, from the county treasury of the county of York. All fees received by him shall be paid over to the county treasurer.'
