IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Payment for Reactors to Bang's Disease.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 297, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 297 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'The commissioner of agriculture shall pay the same rate for all reactors in every county in the state and to the owners of reactors at the time of test whether under supervision or not.'
