STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT to Authorize the Charging off of Uncollectable Accounts Due Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Collection of accounts due counties. County treasurers may charge off the books of account of their respective counties, in whole or in part, such accounts receivable as shall be certified to them as impractical of realization by the boards of county commissioners of their respective counties. The term "accounts receivable" is hereby defined to include taxes due from towns which have exceeded their constitutional debt limit and which by such charge off, in whole or in part, may thereby reduce their debt so that it shall come within said constitutional debt limit.
