STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction of Trial Justices in Certain Parts of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Trial justices in certain parts of Aroostook county to have further jurisdiction. Trial justices, within the territorial limits of the jurisdiction of the Van Buren muncipal court and the Northern Aroostook municipal court, shall have the same criminal jurisdiction as the judges of said courts.
