AN ACT Relating to Records of Deorganized Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1941, c. 161, amended. Chapter 161 of the public laws of 1941 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Records of deorganized municipalities to be deposited in state library. Whenever any city, town or plantation within this state shall become deorganized, the city, town or plantation records ~~shall~~ **may** be turned over to the state library. ~~It shall be the duty of the~~ **The** municipal officers in office at the time of deorganization proceedings ~~to~~ **may** deposit with the state librarian the records of their municipality.'
