**AN ACT Relating to Salary of Adjutant-General.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 125, § 25, amended.** Section 25 of chapter 125 of the revised  
statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

**'Sec. 25. The adjutant-general.** The adjutant-general shall receive an  
annual salary of ~~four thousand dollars~~ \$5,000; he shall receive no other  
fee, emolument, or perquisite.'
